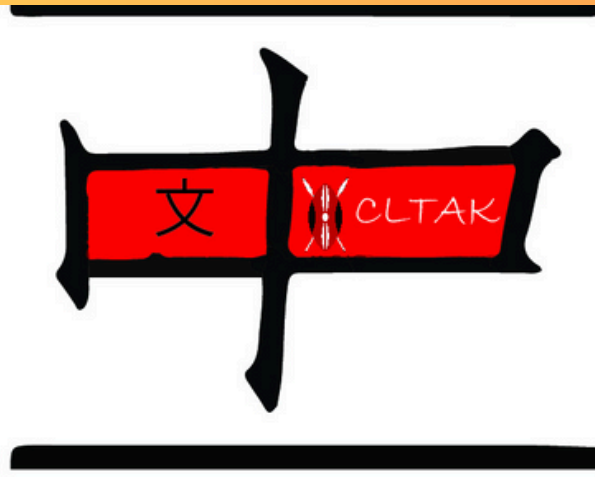
Federico Fellini once said, "A different language is a different vision of life."
